

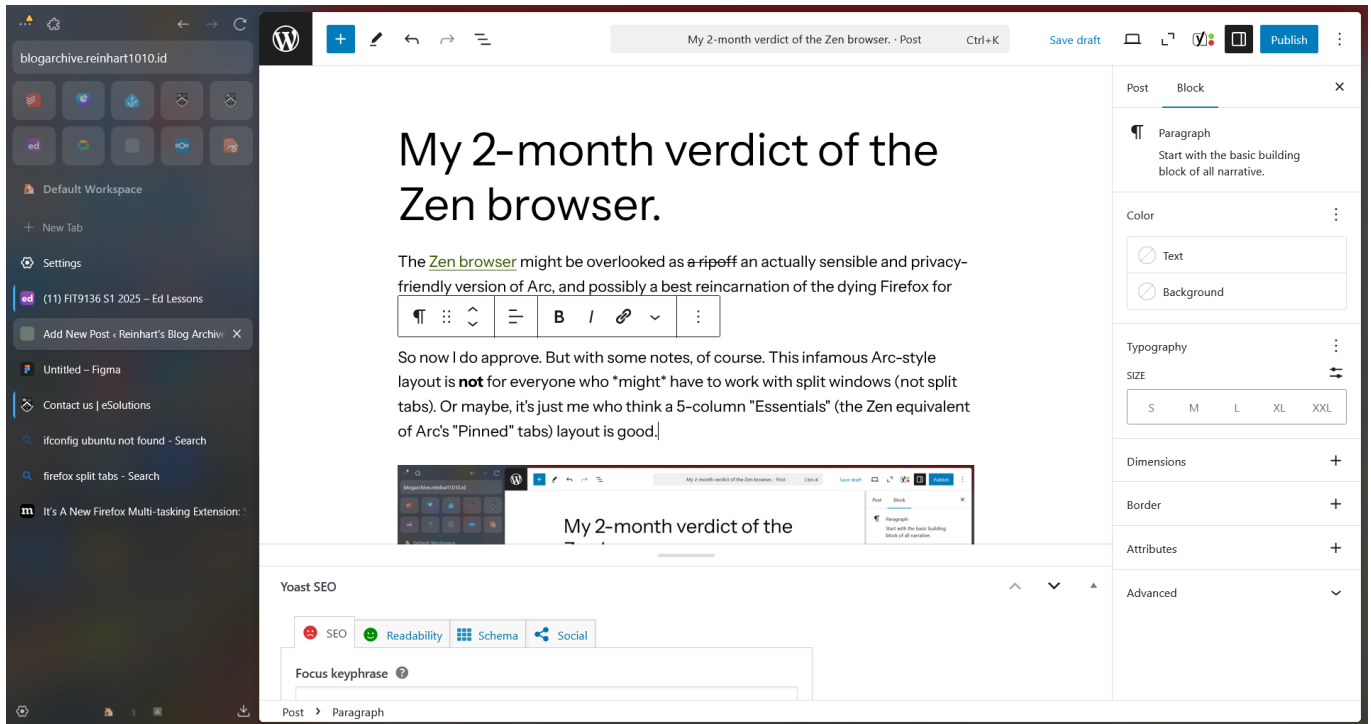
My 2-month verdict of the Zen browser.

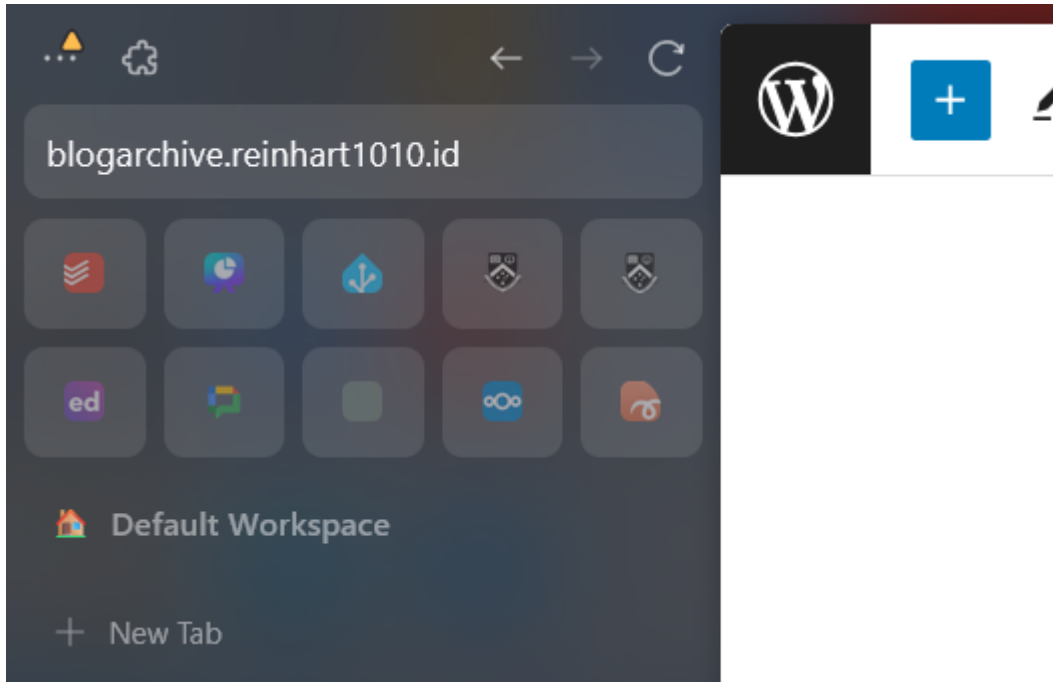
